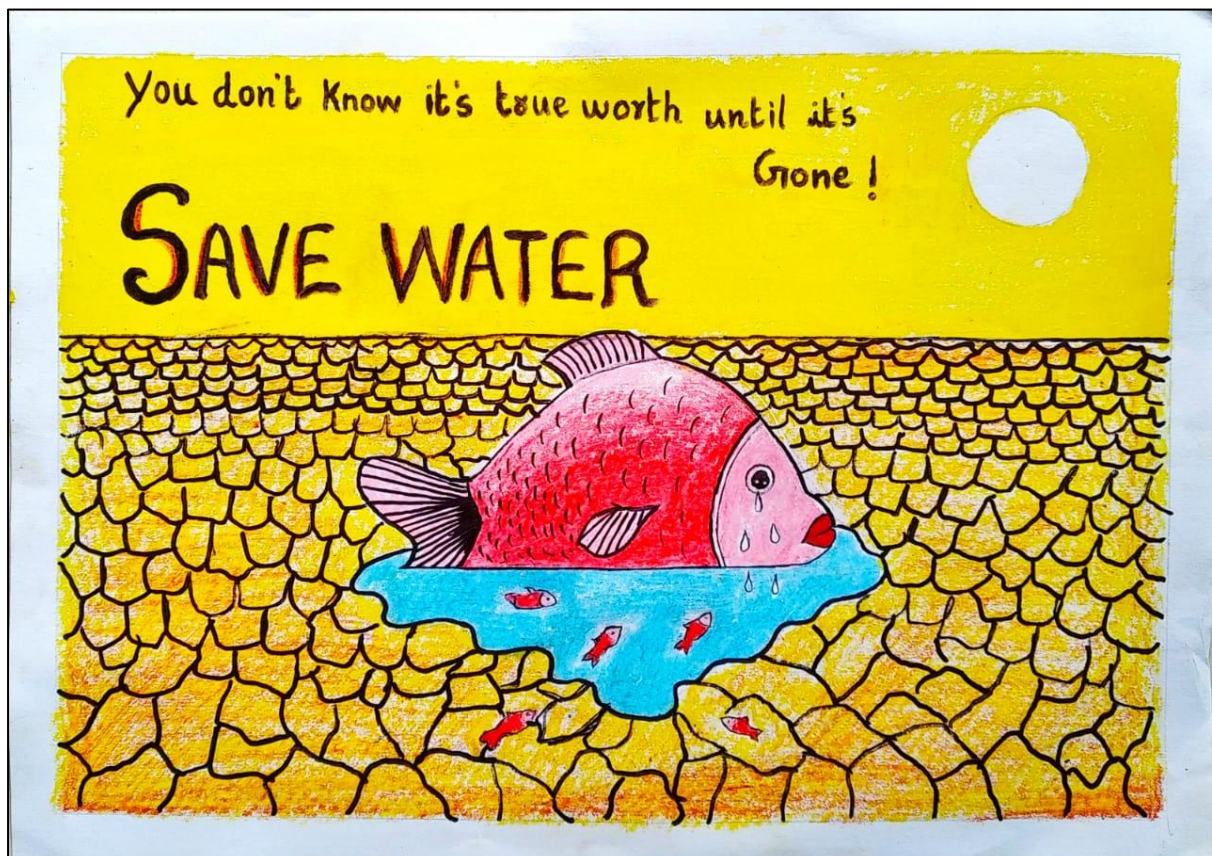
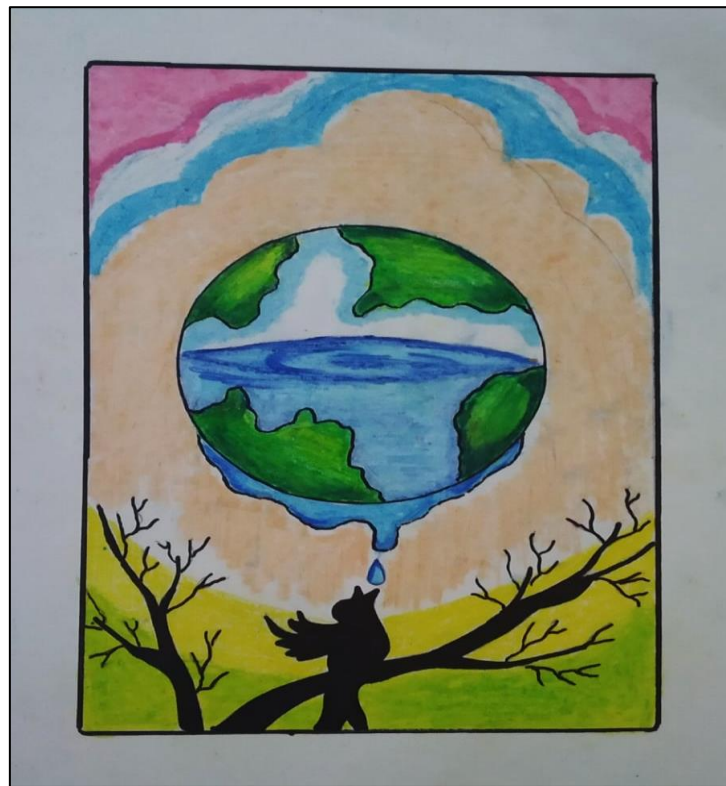
WORLD WATER DAY 2021

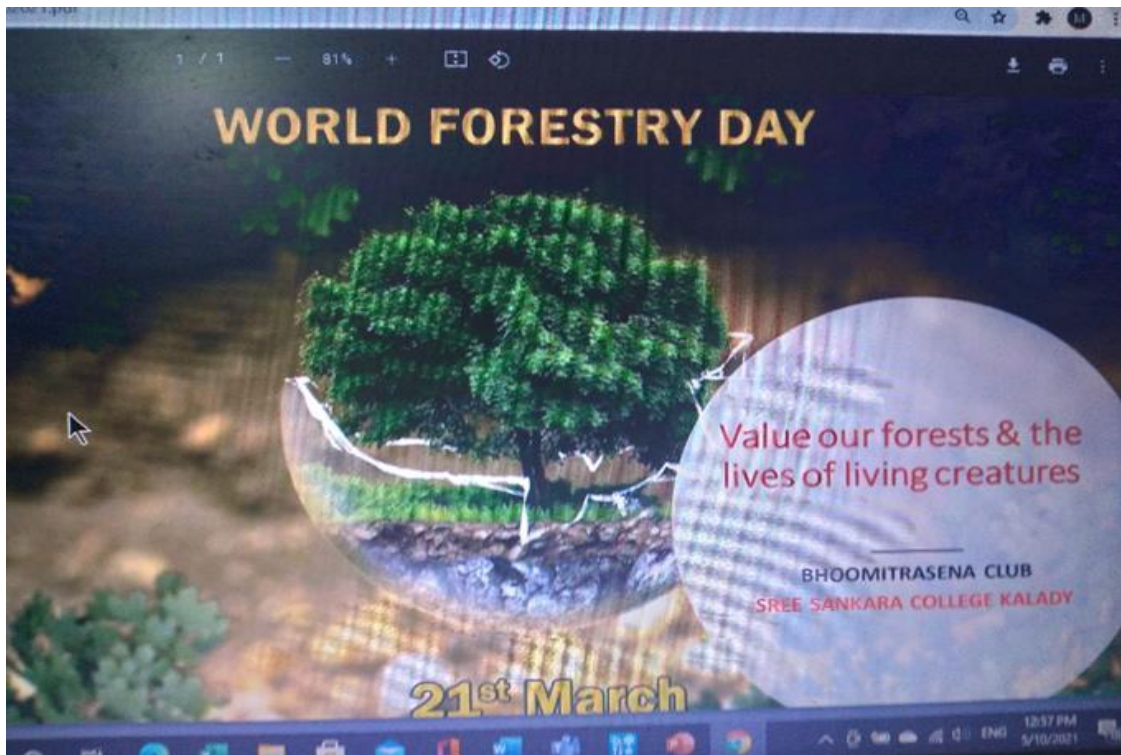
