#### ACTIVITY REPORT -2021-2022

- List of SC/ST students newly admitted in various courses in the academic year was prepared.
- Department wise list of SC/ST students (including B.Voc & Self-financing) was prepared and verified the data with official records.
- Lists of 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> year UG students and 2<sup>nd</sup> year PG students were submitted to the University.
- List of 1<sup>st</sup> year SC/ST students (UG & PG, 2021 Admission) were submitted to the university after the completion of admission process.
- A WhatsApp group of SC/ST/Minority students(2021 Admission) and teachers in the committee was created to share the information directly to the students without any delay.
- The Cell examined and noted the various scholarship schemes given to students, and the guidelines of the scholarship and various programmes conducted by college was shared on this platform.
- Drop out details of SC/ST students admitted in the year 2020 was prepared.
- Details of students availing hostel facility (private/college hostel) was collected.
- A meeting of the SC/ST/Minority Cell of the college was held on December 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021.Issues pertaining to SC/ST and minority students were the topic of discussion. Discussions were held regarding the possibility of conducting innovative programs that would be fruitful for students from these communities. It was decided to conduct a premarital Counselling course for the minority students to educate them about the preparations to be taken before entering in to marital life and the ethical and legal issues in married life, educational and job prospects after marriage. This was conducted in collaboration with the Coaching Center for Minority Youth (CCMY), Mattancherry, working under the directorate of Minority Welfare, Government of India on December 17<sup>th</sup> , 18<sup>th</sup> ,and 21<sup>st</sup> 2021 and on January 7<sup>th</sup> 2022. The aim of the Government in

implementing this program was to reduce the rate of divorces among the younger generation and ensuring a healthy married life. The program was inaugurated by the Ankamaly Block Panchayath member Mr. Sijo Chovvaran and was presided by the Principal Dr. A Suresh. The Principal of the CCMY, Dr. Hazeena V M made the keynote address. Sri. K.T Eldhose Ward Member, Kalady Grama Panchayath gave felicitation. Dr. Preethy Nair IQAC Coordinator delivered vote of thanks. The talks were conducted in eight schedules in a time period of four days. The classes were based on the sociology syllabus of the university of Calicut and the psychology syllabus prepared by Layola College, Trivandrum. The valedictory function was held at the seminar hall. The convenor Smt. Essy C Cherian welcomed the gathering. Dr. A Suresh, the principal gave the presidential address. The COO, Prof. C.P Jaisankar delivered the keynote address. The participants gave their feedback. Dr. Aneesa PA (Member, SC/ST Minority Cell made the concluding remarks. Jeslin Puthussery, a student representative cast the vote of thanks.
