**2019-2020**

- A meeting of SC/ST/Minority Cell of the college was held on August 2019 to bring to the attention of the members issues concerning the SC/ST and Minority students. The committee discussed about the various forms of assistance that could be rendered to these students at the time of admission. It was also decided to update the students about the various perks offered to them by the central and the state governments.
- On August 16<sup>th</sup> 2019, a meeting of the SC/ST Cell Convenors was held by the Vice Chancellor at 2 pm in the M G University assembly hall. The Vice Chancellor directed the institutions to send the details of the pending E - Grantz and hostel fees pertaining to SC/ST students by mail to the SC/ST Cell, MG University. The details were sent as directed.
- Another meeting was held on November 6<sup>th</sup> 2019. The committee took stock of students who failed to receive E Grantz and steps were taken to do the needful. In a reply to a letter dated January 15<sup>th</sup> 2020, to furnish the details of the students in the college, it was reported that out 460 graduates who were promoted 78 students belonged to the SC category in 2016-17, 87 students in 2017-18 and 104 students in 2018-2019 respectively.
- The data for the academic year 2019-2020 with respect to the students belonging to the SC/ST community were furnished as follows to the MG University as Google submit on 14<sup>th</sup> Friday 2020. It was found that the number of SC/ST students admitted through CAP were 103 and 18 respectively. Four of the hostelers were from SC category and six students were from the ST category. A total number of 326 students received E-Grants in the abovementioned academic year. It was found that there were 22 staff members under minority category. Out of them 13 were regular, 8 from self financing and 1 from office.
- The convenor attended a meeting of the SC/ST Cell Convenors of colleges, held on March 2<sup>nd</sup> 2020 at 10.30 at MG University assembly hall. A decision was taken to encourage the research related activities of the students from the SC/ST community.
