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





## SC/ST/MINORITY CELL SREE SANKARA COLLEGE, KALADY REPORT 2022-2023

• The SC/ST/Minority Cell, Sree Sankara College, Kalady organized various programs in the academic year 2022-23. We organized a webinar on 'Minority Welfare Schemes' on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022 in Microsoft Teams platform. The main objective of the program was to make students aware of various types of scholarships, schemes (both central and state). 




• The details of the SC/ST students (2019 pass out PG, 2020 pass out UG) were submitted as the result of the demand made by the CREST in July 2022. Centre for Research, Education and Social Transformation is an autonomous institution formed by the

government of Kerala to address the collective disadvantages faced by the Scheduled and Backward Communities.

Development office, Block Panchayath, Ankamaly organized an awareness class on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022 in the College auditorium. Smt. Revathy Babu welcomed the gathering and Principal Dr. Preethi Nair presided over the function. Sri. Sijo Chowaran, Angamaly Block Panchayath member inaugurated the function. Sri. Eldhose M.P, SC Development Officer, Block Panchayath, Ankamaly was the keynote speaker. He elaborated on all the schemes concerning them, both academic and family welfare schemes. Fifty-nine students participated in the program and the talk was highly beneficial to the students. Smt. We collected the data of the SC/ST and Minority students of 2022 admission from all
departments. We created WhatsApp groups for the convenience of students. Students
could post their queries through these platforms. We ensured whether the first year
students submitted forms for E grantz. Enquiries were conducted with regard to any
difficulties they found in the process. We also collected the personal detail of students

admitted in 2022 through Google forms. We also enquired with the students of 2020 and 2021 admission whether they received the E grantz amount and also asked them to update about the current status of various scholarships and other schemes like laptop, Padanamuri etc.

The cell in association with the Department of Minority Welfare, Government of Kerala and CCMY, Coaching Centre for Minority Youth, Mattanchery organized a 'Pathway-Social Life Wellness programme'. The program was scheduled on January 21st, 24th and 25<sup>th</sup>. Two sessions were held each day. The objectives of the program were, make aware of and prepare for healthy and happy married life among unmarried persons, enhance the knowledge and skills to handle situations in married life and develop confidence and ability for happy and healthy married life. On January 21st, the registration process was held from 9-9.30 am. The inauguration took place at 9.30 am. Smt. Revathy Babu, Convenor SC/ST/Minority Cell gave the welcome address. Dr. Hazeena V.N Principal, CCMY Mattanchery presided over the function. Dr. Anitha Abraham principal in charge, Sree Sankara College, Kalady inaugurated the function. Smt. Gopika G, IQAC Member and Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce offered felicitation. Smt. Lakshmipriya M.R, SC/ST/Minority Cell member and HOD of Malayalam department cast the vote of thanks. The first session began by 10 am. The talks dealt with important issues such as marriage for wellness, Effective communication skills for couples and healthy online communication, Effective management of In-Law relationship and conflict management, Infant and Adolescents, parenting skills, sex education and pregnancy, legal and religious aspects of marriage and Family Budgetting. The students assessed each session and gave their feedback. Students were given tea, snacks and lunch all the three days. The camp ended on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at 5.15 pm and Principal Dr. Preethi Nair distributed the certificates to the participants.
