



ABSTRACT

Recent floods caused widespread damage to human life, property and the infrastructure of our state. It will be incredibly traumatic and stressful to those who experience natural disasters. The effect of the flood is a powerful reminder of the type of disaster experienced by many communities around Kerala and the need for effective relief. Current natural disasters offer a perfect way to combine science with real-life events. It also brings into focus the role education in preparing for and preventing natural disaster. Recognizing the need for better preparedness and funding, the importance of quality education in times of crisis and conflict is emphasized and this is the thought behind the selection of the topic of the seminar

OBJECTIVES

- Use of Science to prepare students and their families to face natural disasters
- Promote disaster risk reduction
- Teach basic scientific concepts related to climate change and sustainable practices

EXPECTED OUTCOME

- Students can build up confidence to explore environmental issues, engage in problem solving, and take action to improve the environment.
- Students develop a deeper understanding of environmental disasters and have the skills to face and tackle the emergency situations

TWO DAY SEMINAR ON TEACHING SCIENCE AMIDST CALAMITIES

The 2 day seminar on Teaching Science amidst Calamities was organised by Dept. of Zoology on 31st December, 2019 & 1st January, 2020. The registration started at 9.30 am. 225 participants attended the event. Students from neighouring colleges were also present. Dr. A Suresh Principal, Dr. T.V Sajeev, Principal Scientist Forest Entomology KFRI Thrissur and Sri S Prasad IQAC Member and Faculty of Economics Department were present. The program began with the worship of God by Ms. Devika Babu of I year Zoology. Dr. Mini K D, HOD of Zoology and the Program Coordinator marked the welcome address. Principal inaugurated the event and he emphasized the role of education in equipping the student community to face the natural disasters. He recapped the 2018 flood scenario of Kalady. Sri. S Prasad, IQAC Member, recorded felicitation. Dr. T.V Sajeev, in the key note 'Learning Science in the Anthropocene towards New Syllabi' he oriented the audience on the need of moulding the curriculum which can fit the students to face the calamities effectively and efficiently. The Anthropocene describes the idea of a new geological epoch distinguished by the geological scale of human impacts on the Earth's surface, atmosphere, oceans, and systems of nutrient cycling. Other organisms, like the cyanobacteria that oxygenated the atmosphere two billion years ago, have disrupted earth systems. The first species that's become a planet-scale influence and is aware of that reality?" How do we make sense of this? Does our status as a world-altering species evoke hubris or humility? And what does the shift from the predictable and habitable climate of the Holocene to the climate instability of the Anthropocene mean in terms of our future? He presented the topic effectively and the session was fruitful for all the participants. In the winding up of the forenoon session Dr. Minimol K C, of Dept. of Zoology delivered vote of thanks.

The meeting adjourned for lunch at 12.30 pm.

The afternoon session began at 1.30 pm. Ms. Jismi Poulose of II year Zoology welcomed the guest speaker Dr. Abhilash S Asst. Professor, Dept. of Atmospheric Sciences, and CUSAT. Dr. Abhilash spoke on the topic 'Climate Change & Challenges in attaining Sustainable Development Goals.' Global environmental challenges, such as impacts of climate change, loss of biodiversity, over-use of natural resources and environmental and health issues, are

critically linked to issues of poverty and the sustainability of ecosystems, and consequently, issues of resource security and political stability. Education is an essential element of the global response to climate change. It helps people understand and address the impact of global warming, increases "climate literacy" among young people, encourages changes in their attitudes and behaviour, and helps them adapt to climate change related trends. The participants shoed deep involvement in his presentation. The session was over by 3.30 pm. Students interacted well after the talk. Ms. Shallot of II year Zoology delivered vote of thanks.




TWO DAY NATIONAL SEMINAR ON REORGANISATION OF PUBLIC SECTOR BANKS: A BOON OR A BANE






Research and Postgraduate Department of Chemistry

The Department of Economics in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sree Sankara College under the Sree Sankara Management Aid for Research and Transformation (SMART) scheme organised a Four Day Online Workshop on Heterodox Economics on 22, 23, 24 and 25 September 2020.

The Workshop

Heterodox economics is the analysis and principles considered outside mainstream or orthodox schools of economic thought. Schools of heterodox economics include socialism, Marxism, Post-Keynesianism, institutionalism, evolutionary economics, feminist and green economics.

The newly constituted Mahatma Gandhi University PG Board of Studies in Economics with a view to fill such an intellectual gap among the budding students of economics, decided to introduce a course on Heterodox economics in the third semester of M A Degree Programme (2019 admissions onwards). The primary objective of the workshop was to build up a better understanding of different schools of thought in the area of Heterodox Economics among the teachers of economics and post graduate students.




Screenshot from the National Webinar on Energy Analytics in Buildings

Unlike organic contaminants, these pollutants are not biodegradable and can be transferred through the food chain via bioaccumulation. The build-up of dangerous concentrations of toxic metals in water sources and grains and vegetables grown in contaminated soils is critically alarming due to the harmful effects of metals on human life and aquatic biota. The actual challenge is to develop innovative and cost-effective solutions to decontaminate polluted environments and to protect the functioning of ecosystems. **"Bioremediation of Diesel hydrocarbons using yeast species"** – this talk encouraged the applications of Microbes in Biodegradation and bioremediation of pollutants in an eco-friendly manner.


BioFiesta 2021-An International Webinar Series






International Webinar Series- "Biofiesta -2023"


Brochure of the International Webinar Series BIOFIESTA 2023

About Energy Auditing

The primary objective of Home Energy Audit is **to determine ways to reduce energy consumption per unit of product output or to lower operating costs** while using household equipment. An energy audit simply determines the energy efficiency at residential or commercial buildings. It will certainly provide a complete electricity consumption and energy efficiency assessment. By conducting an energy audit survey on

our college locality, it will help the local people to understand their energy usage pattern, energy saving options etc. This will make the common man literate on the field of energy security.

Our students will be given proper training to conduct the survey and it is expected to cover 20 houses within a duration of one month. As an extension of this programme our students can guide the locals about the new schemes, subsidies etc. offered in government sectors to promote the rooftop panel installations. Our training partner will help the students with the survey. **Before starting the auditing work, our students attended a 3 day workshop on energy auditing on December 12th to 14th. The student attended classes on Campus Energy Audit conducted by Energy Conservation Society. It was a three day Energy awareness programme .The theme of the program was renewable Energy, Green Technology and energy efficiency.**

A structured methodology to carry out an energy audit is necessary for efficient working. An initial study of the site should always be carried out, as the planning of the procedures necessary for an audit is most important. Initial survey was completed within a duration of one month (December,2022 and January,2023) for 20 houses near the college.

Outcome

- Students were made aware of energy auditing and its possible career options. They are now familiar with energy conservation techniques.
- They got good verbal skills on customer interaction and gained specific marketing tips
- Teachers were equipped to develop the specific skills required to teach energy security.
- This program changed the mindset of our students and helped them to focus on their core career options.


