## **Summary of Activity Reports- 2023-24**

### **College Student Council**

The college union inauguration took place on October 30, 2023, commencing at 10:30 AM. The official inaugural session followed, graced by the honorable MLA, Roji M John, who inaugurated the function. The ceremony was attended by Principal Preethi Nair, Chairperson Bobin John, Staff Advisor K.P. Suni, and other union members. The program continued until 4:30 PM, featuring a diverse range of cultural performances by students, making it a memorable and enriching experience for all.

### **Keralapiravi Celebration**

Keralapiravi celebrations were held on November 1, 2023. The event commenced at noon with a vibrant procession, featuring students clad in traditional attire, accompanied by drum beats. Principal Preethi Nair, Staff Advisor K.P. Suni, teachers, and students participated in the procession, which marched from the college to Mattoor junction. - Conducting a detailed inquiry by interviewing both the complainant and the accused, along with witnesses.
- Informing the local police, UGC Anti-Ragging Helpline, and other relevant authorities.
- Submitting an official report to the head of the institution with recommendations.

### **3. Anti-Ragging Week Celebration**

**Details:**

As part of the Anti-Ragging Week celebration, the cell organized an essay competition to promote awareness and creative expression against ragging. The competition was open to all students, and the best essays were awarded cash prizes.
