



Report

The Work Readiness Program organized by the ASAP Community Skill Park, Perumbavoor, in collaboration with the Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission and the Higher Education Department of the Government of Kerala during 25/10/2023, 26/10/2023 and 28/10/2023, aimed to prepare candidates for job interviews and enhance their employability skills. This free, three-day program was a vital initiative designed to provide guidance and practical training to those preparing for competitive examinations and job interviews.

Objective

The primary objectives of the program included:

- 1. Developing critical skills required for job interviews and professional settings.
- 2. Enhancing candidates' confidence in communication, presentation, and interview etiquette.
- 3. Bridging the gap between academic knowledge and real-world requirements, especially in competitive scenarios.

Program Overview

The Work Readiness Program spanned over three days and included the following key elements:

1. Day 1: Orientation and Soft Skills Development

- o Introduction to workplace expectations and professional behavior.
- Training in communication skills and interpersonal relations.

2. Day 2: Resume Building and Mock Interviews

- o Guidance on crafting effective resumes tailored to job roles.
- o Role-playing exercises to simulate real-world interview scenarios.

3. Day 3: Career Guidance and Skill Assessment

- Individual counseling sessions focusing on career pathways, including competitive exams and job market strategies.
- Skill assessments to identify strengths and areas of improvement.

Relevance to Competitive Examinations

The program also incorporated modules that supported preparation for competitive examinations, with a focus on:

- 1. Problem-solving techniques and analytical skills, essential for exams like CAT, SSC, and bank recruitments.
- 2. Time management strategies for tackling aptitude and reasoning sections.
- 3. Confidence-building exercises that are crucial for personal interviews and group discussions, often part of exam selection processes.




Preliminary Exam



identify candidates with the requisite knowledge and skills for further evaluation. From the pool of participants, six students successfully cleared the preliminary round and advanced to the interview stage.












Career Guidance Session




